
PUSS IN THE CORNER QUILT BLOCK KIT

Beginner Level


Kit contains precut pieces to make one 8 inch finished block. Please read through all instructions before you begin. All seams are ¼"

Pieces measure:


- A 4 2 ½" x 4 ½ inch rectangles, matching, for sides.
- B 2-2½" squares, light;
 - 2 2 1/2" squares, dark;
 - 4 2 ½" squares, matching, for outer corners;




With the 2 light and 2 dark 2 1/2" (B) squares, form the center of the block, sewing a light square to a dark square and press the seam toward the dark square. Repeat with the other two squares. Sew the two sets of squares together along one side to form a 4 1/2" square with the dark pieces in opposite corners. This forms the center of your block.



Lay out all your pieces as in the diagram and sew the block together as in a nine patch: for the top row, sew one of the 4 matching squares to the short side of a rectangle (A) and finish with another of the matching squares. Press both seams in toward the rectangle. For the middle row, sew together the long side of a rectangle with the 4 patch and finish with another rectangle. Press both seams out toward the rectangles. The bottom row is identical to the first.



Sew the top row to the middle and then the bottom row to the middle. Press seams toward the top and bottom.



Lay the block right side up when finished and press, checking that the block is 8 1/2" square. You can help square the block if needed by pressing with steam and gently stretching.
