

FINISHING KIT

Kit contains precut pieces to join the 6 civil war quilt blocks (separate kits) into a small quilt top suitable for a wall hanging or table runner/centerpiece.

Finished size: approx 32" x 22"

Note: materials and instructions for layering, quilting, and binding into a finished product are not included here.

Please read through all instructions before you begin. Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance for all seams.



Contents:

12 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " cornerstones

17 - $8\frac{1}{2}$ x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " sashing strips

Step 1:

Sew a horizontal strip of 3 cornerstones and 2 sashing strips:



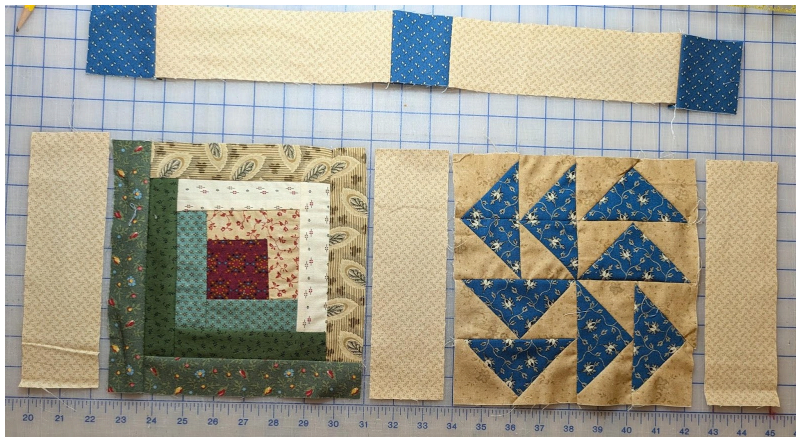
Press seams toward the sashing.

Sew three more for a total of four.



Step 2:

Gather two of the six completed blocks (available separately) and sew a sashing strip between them, and one on each end of the row. (Photo shows a sashing strip above them. They will be the same width after sewing.)



Do the same for the remaining 4 completed blocks. You should have three wide rows of quilt blocks with sashing.



Step 3:

Sew the rows of sashing, and rows of blocks, together:

First, sew a row of sashing above the first block row:



Then do the same for the other two block rows, and sew a row of sashing to the bottom of the third row, and sew them all together. See Page 1 for photo of completed quilt top, ready for layering with batting and backing, quilting, and binding.
